Specification Content: The ways in which Buddhists read these narratives. 20-Mark Questions:

- Explain/Examine the key events of the Buddha's birth and early life.
- Explain/Examine the meanings of the conception dream of Maya.
- Explain/Examine the significance of the prophecy concerning the Buddha's life.
- Explain/Examine the significance of Suddhodana's response to the prophecy concerning the Buddha's life.
- Explain/Examine the relationship of the Four Sights to the three marks of existence.
- Compare different interpretations of the conception dream of Maya.
- Compare different interpretations of the birth of the Buddha.
- Compare different interpretations of the prophecy about the life of the Buddha.
- Compare different interpretations of the early life of the Buddha.

30-Mark Questions:
