20-Mark Questions:

- Explain/Examine the nature of the Vinaya Pitaka.

- Explain/Examine the nature of the Sutta Pitaka.
- Explain/Examine the reasons why the Sutta Pitaka appeals to all Buddhists.
- Explain/Examine the nature of the Abhidhamma.
- Explain/Examine the importance of the Abidhamma in the development of Buddhist thought.
- Explain/Examine the nature of the Pali Cannon.
- Explain/Examine the importance of the Pali Cannon as a source of wisdom.

30-Mark Questions:
